WELL WATER TESTING REQUIREMENTS FOR:

- Newly constructed wells

The Connecticut Department of Public Health, through the action of the Connecticut General Assembly, adopted the following requirements for well water testing:

1. ***ALL*** water samples must be collected by a “qualified individual” under the direction of a licensed laboratory, a state certified operator as defined in Section 25-32-7a(c) of the regulations of state agencies, or a licensed sanitarian.
2. A signed statement by the “qualified individual”, including location and address of the well, must be provided to FVHD along with the laboratory analysis.
3. The well water **MUST NOT** exceed the maximum contaminant levels (MCL) of the Connecticut Public Health Code.
4. The water must be analyzed for:

a. Total Coliform Bacteria	h. Hardness
b. Nitrate	i. Turbidity
c. Nitrite	j. pH
d. Sodium	k. Sulfate
e. Chloride	l. Apparent Color
f. Iron	m. Odor
	n. Lead
	o. Arsenic
	p. Uranium
	q. Volatile Organic Chemicals (VOC)
g. Manganese	Seven listed pesticides/herbicides, if the nitrate level is over 10.0 mg/L

When the results are mailed or faxed to the Farmington Valley Health District, a Water Certification Form with signature of the person who took the sample must be included. This is a State Regulation.
